ST MARGARET'S CHAPEL WEDDINGS

Say 'I do' in Scotland's most famous landmark – the majestic fortress of Edinburgh Castle. Celebrate your wedding ceremony in the beautiful setting of this 12th Century Chapel, originally built by King David I as a private chapel for the royal family and dedicated to his mother, Margaret.

This is the smallest of our venues here at Edinburgh Castle and can accommodate up to 30 people for a Religious ceremony only. You would have access to the chapel for one hour: half an hour for the ceremony and half an hour prior to the ceremony for your guests to arrive. After the ceremony, wedding photography is taken on the lawn of the Scottish National War Memorial lawn area adjacent to the chapel itself. On a Friday and Saturday, the latest time for a ceremony in the chapel is 2pm. From Sunday through to Thursday, you could have your ceremony later on in the day based around the opening hours of the Castle.

We also have drinks and canapés reception packages, and lunch packages available which can be served after the ceremony. (These cannot be served within the Chapel itself, and will be served in other areas of the Castle grounds, subject to availability).

Edinburgh Castle is primarily a visitor attraction which can attract up to 10,000 visitors during the busy summer season. We aim to work as a wedding venue and visitor attraction, due to this restrictions are in place. From May to late September/early October Edinburgh Castle's esplanade is home to the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo. The arena is built from early May and is dismantled during September/October. As this is in the care of the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo, maintenance is out-with our control. Due to the Tattoo dates, we are unable to accept wedding bookings during August.

We suggest that you book an appointment to come and view our on-site wedding venues and we can explain to you the workings of a Wedding Day at Edinburgh Castle.
